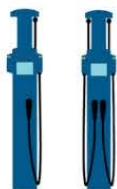




Beginner's guide to providing EV charging at work

What type of charging do I need?

Level 2 AC charging is perfect for workdays. Since there are longer dwell times at work, employees can plug in for a few hours and get charged up before their commute home.



Who has station access?

Limit access to employees during work hours to guarantee availability. Open stations to the public after hours for a fee to generate revenue and help cover your workplace charging costs.



How can I make charging easy and efficient?

Waitlist lets employees get in line at charging stations when all locations are busy and conveniently notifies them when it's time to go plug in. It's that simple.



How can I measure usage and impact?

Reporting is an essential tool for any workplace EV charging program. With it, you'll be able to measure the impact of your program and align it to employee satisfaction, environmental goals and much more.
